Tsunami Warning



As most of you are aware, on January 23, 2018 there was an evacuation warning for our community. The siren at the Fire Hall was activated. We would like to thank everyone for their support during the evacuation, as well as all the volunteers that helped during this emergency. We would also like to remind our residents that our Community Center is the Emergency Reception Center in case of any major disaster. Also, in case you were not aware, Skeena Drive (Highway 599R) is considered High Ground. The main risk areas during a Tsunami are those closer to the water and below Skeena Drive.

If you have any questions call our office during an emergency or come to the Community Center for updated information.

Monday nights are practice nights for our volunteer Fire Department and the siren will be activated during practices on the 1st Monday of each month.

Dog License—Due January 2018



2018 Dog licenses are available at the Municipal Office.

All dogs over 6 months of age must be licensed through the Municipal Office. We encourage our residents to come in at the beginning of the year between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm to register your pet and receive your current dog tag.

Fees are \$10.00 for every spayed or neutered dog; \$20.00 for unneutered males and \$50 for non spayed females.
