We will however pick up your white goods (appliances for the cost of the recycling fee). Please prepay at the Municipal Office.

## Derelict Vehicles



The District of Port Edward, will once again, be offering an opportunity to remove derelict vehicles at no charge. You will be required to fill out a form, including you VIN number, personal information and signature.

We will then make arrangements for the vehicles to be picked up. Deadline for this program is **May 31, 2017**.

Effective **June 1, 2017** derelict vehicles will no longer be allowed to be parked in Residential Neighbourhoods.

Also, be advised that spring maintenance has started. Please remove all vehicles, recreational vehicles and boats from lawns, so it does not hamper the grass cutting.
